Looking Ahead to 2022-2023 School Year

- Looking forward to next school year, some key events on the Booster horizon are:
 - A renewed commitment to the membership drive during residency days: new spirit wear, giveaways, and a
 big push to get our volunteers engaged again after the pandemic pause and back to a regular pace of
 events!
 - Prioritization of improved Booster communications with RB coaches
 - 'Team Reps' will be a formal Booster committee, allowing resources and oversight
 - Redesign of the Booster website to allow for a more user-friendly platform for coaches to explore Booster resources
 - Engagement of coaches to help coordinate Senior Banners
 - Continue trend of increased funding requests. In last two school years, funding has increased, with a nearly three-fold increase between the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 school years. We would like to maintain or improve this growth trend moving into next year.

- We were extremely lucky this year to have the time and talents of Stefanie and Chris Hajer. Stefanie brought her graphic design background to an overhaul of the seasonal programs and website elements. Chris is our IT expert and has spent countless hours working to integrate payment systems, automate collection of information and files, and improve the website interface.

Concessions

Amy Raymond and Brian Twomey worked diligently all year to get the concessions areas cleaned, stocked
and ready for business. Amy oversaw the coordination of concession volunteers, and it was more of a
challenge this year, with a fewer overall number of concessions volunteers. We hope to reengage more
parents next year!

Booster Senior Scholarship

- Michelle Ruska, on behalf of RB Boosters, presented our third annual slate of RB Sports Boosters Senior Bulldog Scholarships.
 - Boosters awarded scholarships to 4 Bulldog student athletes (2 male, 2 female for a total of 4 Bulldogs each receiving \$500).
 - The Booster Executive Board is committed to seeing that this scholarship offering is available year over year.

Bulldog Bonanza

- This event, which is an online raffle held via Facebook, debuted in the 2020-2021 school year and made an appearance twice this school year as well.
 - We are up to over 1200 members joined—and we continued to partner with dozens of local businesses to make auction offerings.
 - It resulted in a fundraising PROFIT this school year of more than \$28,220.90.

TouchPro

- The Booster membership voted to approve the funding of a TouchPro screen to enhance the school.
 - TouchPro is an interactive touch screen that will have three main parts:
 - An All-School Event Calendar (software allows seamless and automatic syncing with district and sport schedules)
 - A rolling slide show (editable as often as we'd like)
 - 3 home buttons to cover academics, athletics, and the arts with content embedded within each of the buttons completely customizable
- Details and timing are still being worked out with school leadership.
- The final digital product will include a 'thank you' to Brian Twomey for his many years of service to Boosters and the positive financial impact he made during his tenure.



Golf Outing Returns

- Boosters is excited to be bringing back the Annual Golf Outing fundraiser (June 18, 2022).
